

PACKING LIST

- Pillow, sheets, and blanket (or sleeping bag).
- Bath towels.
- Toiletries (toothbrush, soap, shampoo, etc).
- A complete Bible, notepad, and pen for Bible Study and Worship.
- Appropriate clothing (see Dress Code below).
- Neon T-shirts and attire/ accessories for dodgeball.
- Sturdy, closed-toe, walking shoes and a backup pair. The mission sites will require a lot of time on foot.
- Other attire appropriate for being in the hot sun all day but will also dry quickly if it rains (hats, athletic shirts and shorts, etc.)
- Disposable rain poncho.
- Sunscreen and insect repellent.
- Spending Money. There MAY be some small opportunities for students to make purchases at neighborhood convenience stores, buy some coffee/snacks at Trinity, and Crossings merchandise.
- Reusable water bottle.
- Wristwatch: we do not want you to miss any part of your exciting week of camp!
- Missions Offering Money (Recommend \$20 for student camp). We recommend you bring hand soap, bath mats, and hand/ paper towels.

GROUP PACKING LIST

- Anti-itch cream (Lanacane)
- Sunburn relief (Green Aloe with Lidocaine)
- First Aid Kit – triple antibiotic ointment, ace bandages, anti-bacterial wipes, & epipen.
- Pain Medications (Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Chewable Aspirin, etc.)
- Extra hand soap, paper towels, and bathmats
- Bandages
- Gold Bond
- Toll pass or money (including quarters)
- First Aid Kit
- Sheet or blanket for group to sit on during lunch at missions site

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs.
- Fireworks or weapons of any kind.
- Skateboards, roller skates, or shoes with built in skates.

DRESS CODE

We ask that all students and adults dress modestly. For females and males, shorts need to be longer than fingertips when arm is extended down the side of leg. We do not allow spaghetti strap tank tops, any tops where undergarments can be seen, or any shirts with the sides cut out. Swimsuits must be one piece, no exceptions. For females, shorts must be worn over swimsuits at all times, even in the water. For both males and females, shirts must be worn at all times when walking to and from the lake/pool.
