

1ST TIME GROUP LEADERS

Below you will find helpful descriptions of some Crossings lingo that will give you and your students context on what we mean when we mention one of the items below.

CHURCH CONNECT

This is your time to connect with your students. Each day, there is an opportunity in the schedule for you to do what you understand to be the most helpful with your group. We have written some material that coordinates with the Large Group & Small Group lessons for your use, but it is up to you if you want to use that. Regardless of what you decide, your students will be looking to you for some direction. Some groups encourage their students to rest or get cleaned up, some do *TAWG (Time Alone With God)*, and some go over our material. It's totally up to you!

CHURCH CHECKPOINT

Our desire is to always direct your students back to you in the significant decisions they are making at camp. As a result, we have scheduled time for you to check in with your students every night after worship. They will always be directed to respond to the invitation with their group leaders. Checkpoint follows evening worship so you can follow up with the students with whom the Lord is doing work.

POIS

These POINTS OF IMPACT (POI) are our opportunity to entertain and engage your students with activities and communicate the Gospel to your students. They select their POIs upon arrival at property and these selections will be given to you at the opening group leader meeting.

FELLOWSHIP

This is a gathering of the entire camp on one evening of camp (the day depends on the camp property) for a fun, energetic, and festive party-like experience. It will take place during Shack and all Shack attractions still happen during the fellowship. Our desire is for there to be a special night of dressing up with a few exciting surprises along the way.

THE SHACK

Each night, we will finish up with some great activities and some delicious junk food. This takes place at "The Shack," which is our concession stand. The Shack is open during lake rotations and at the end of each day!

CROSSBOWL

Crossbowl is a camp-wide competition where small groups, divided by their color, compete to be the ultimate Crossbowl Champion at the end of the session. Each morning, small groups will compete in team activities, ending with a final competition on the last night.
