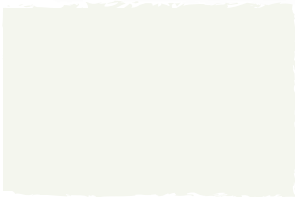

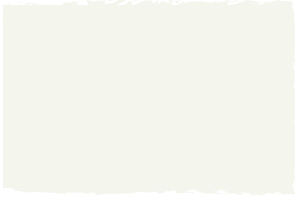

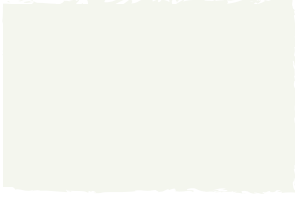

DAY TWO

SCRIPTURE:

Matthew 8:1–4

MAIN POINT:

God is with us. Jesus' life shows us His character and power. We can trust that He is both able and willing to restore sinful people.

◆ READ: ISAIAH 41:9-10


In these verses, God shares that He has chosen each one of us for a special and unique reason. He tells us that He is always with us, no matter where we go. Even in the "farthest corners" of the world, God is there!

Sometimes we can feel unimportant or like we are less than others; this is not true! God made every person in His image and loves His creation! He will always be with us, to give us strength when we feel weak, and pick us up when we fall. You were made by the One True God and He has called you to share His story with the world!

DAY TWO

Has there ever been a time in your life when you felt unimportant? Maybe there was a moment at school or with your friends when you felt “less than.” Remember, these feelings are not from God. Turn to Him and His Holy Word for the Truth. His Word says that YOU are special and that He has called YOU for a mighty purpose!

SCRIPTURE:

MAIN POINT:

God is for us. Jesus has the authority to forgive and restore. He frees His people from payback and gives us new life with Him forever.

Time Alone with God

During TAWG, you get the opportunity to spend some time with you and God. You get to pray/talk with God. Find a spot where you won't get distracted and talk to God about what you are thinking about today.

◆ READ: ROMANS 8:31-32

Praise God! He sent His only Son to die for our sins so that we might believe, follow Jesus, and have eternal life. Our Lord Jesus is the perfect example of God's everlasting love. God's love for us is so powerful that the Bible says that absolutely nothing and no one could ever be against us!

Because God is for us, we will never be defeated. Jesus took on all our sins and defeated death; this means we will never have to face a life without Him. When we live our lives in service to God, nothing will ever be against us.

There are times when we will feel defeated because we did not make a good grade on our test, or because we did not get to play in the basketball game. Even in these times, we have to remember that God is with us and that His plan for

our lives is still true and still happening! Feeling defeated in moments like these is different than being defeated. God will never let us be defeated! Jesus has already defeated it all by dying on the cross!

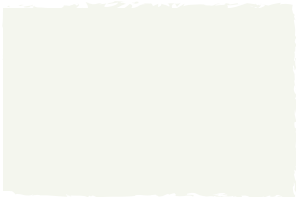

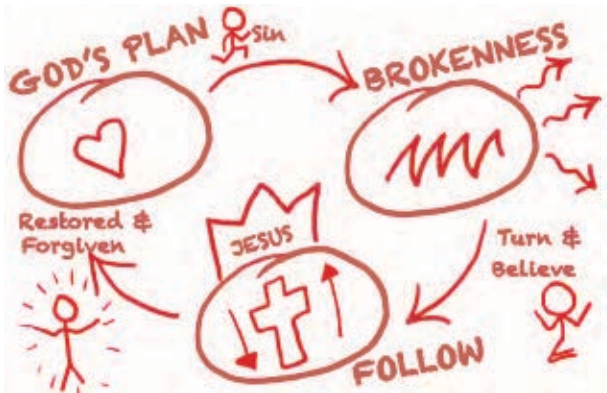
